The trend set in the first quarter continues with the fourth successive buoyant month. OTC Volumes in the gas markets and UK Power have increased year to date on 2013. UK NBP gas up 11.20% and the European gas hubs by a massive 54.93% YTD. UK Power continued its good run with the best month since March 2011 and 36.33% up on 2013. Coal swap volumes are 5.86% up compared to 2013.



The major focus of the month was on the UK Power market. The two one hour market making windows started on 31st March. What impact would they have on liquidity? One month is too short a period to make a judgment. Volumes were up but the evidence suggests this was more to do with activity in the gas market than the impact of the market making windows.
